



## 2010 Summer Orono Youth Boys Lacrosse – Registration

Lacrosse teams are now forming for boys in grades 3<sup>rd</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup>. The Boys divisions will be 3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>/6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> grades. The season begins end of May and runs through July (State tournament is first weekend in August). Practices will begin when the fields are available in May.

Participants are required to be members of US Lacrosse. Members will receive comprehensive insurance coverage, Lacrosse magazines, plus other benefits. To become a member and to learn more, register online at [www.lacrosse.org](http://www.lacrosse.org). The youth membership fee is \$25 and is paid directly to USL in addition to the Orono Youth Lacrosse Association registration fee of \$150 for 3<sup>rd</sup> / 4<sup>th</sup> or \$225 for the 5/6 and 7/8 grade levels. There is also a Supplemental Coaches Fee of \$50 for the 5/6 and 7/8 levels. The registration fee includes uniforms, referees, field fees, coach fees, goalie equipment (for each team) and membership in Youth Lacrosse Minnesota.

**ALL players will need to be current as of April 2010 with their US Lacrosse numbers. If your player's membership expires some time during this season, you will need to renew before the season starts. ALL players must show proof of lacrosse number and expiration date at time of registration.**

- Registrations must be received by **April 15, 2010**. Up to April 15th, registration priority will be given to players residing in the Orono School District (#278). If there is space on a team, players from other school districts will be included on a team based on the order (by date) the registration was received by OYLA. After April 15th until the close of registration, OYLA will work on a first come - first served basis.
- Players residing in a district that currently has a YLM association must register with that association. Exceptions are allowed for open-enrolled students and private school students. In both cases, players may register with the association in that community.

**Equipment:** Full gear must be worn for all practices and games. Full gear for boys consists of a lacrosse helmet (white preferred), mouth guard, shoulder & elbow pads, athletic cup, stick, and lacrosse gloves. Additional gear for goalies will be supplied by the association. Hockey helmets / gloves will not be allowed.

Player Code of Conduct

Playing lacrosse for the Orono Youth Lacrosse Association (OYLA) and Youth Lacrosse Minnesota (YLM) is a privilege. As with all privileges, there is responsibility. One of your responsibilities as a member of the OYLA is to conduct yourself in a way that reflects positively on yourself, your coach, your teammates, the OYLA and the game of lacrosse. The OYLA strives to maintain a reputation for a high level of sportsmanship. Achieving this starts with you! Players who do not conduct themselves appropriately may be subject to discipline (by either OYLA or YLM or both) that could include removal from the club or membership in the YLM. Listed below are some of the behaviors you are expected to exhibit at all times:

1. I will control my language and not use foul or inappropriate language while participating in lacrosse related activities.
2. I will never taunt or yell at opposing players / teams.
3. I will treat my fellow teammates with respect.
4. I will respect my opponents and shake hands at the completion of the game. (This is not always easy depending on how the opposition conducts itself. Rise above the others who do not represent the game of lacrosse favorably.)
5. I will respect the game officials and shake their hands at the completion of the game. I will remember that they are in control of the field and acknowledge that they are human and make mistakes. Open confrontation with the officials will not serve my team well. The officials will have the last word even if it results in coaches / players being sent off the field.
6. I will follow and learn from my coaches' direction.
7. I will work hard to improve my lacrosse skills and knowledge.
8. I will play hard and fair at all times.
9. I will try at all times to follow all OYLA and YLM rules and policies.
10. I will follow the rules of the game at all times.

I have read and understand this OYLA Players Code of Conduct. I understand that any violation of this code may result in disciplinary action against me. This code of conduct will be enforced for the current lacrosse season.
